Dear Young Person and Parent / Carer,

Human Papillomavirus (HPV) vaccination to protect against various cancers

We are offering all young people in school years 9 to 11 the Human Papillomavirus (HPV) vaccination in school, during the academic year from September 2022 to August 2023. The programme is first offered when young people are in school year 8.

The vaccination offers protection against up to nine HPV strains, which can cause various cancers in both males and females. It is a two dose course given as an injection in the upper arm, six to 24 months apart.
