## Krakow – Poland – October 2024

I am delighted to announce that we are planning a 4-Day trip to Krakow in October 2024. This is a fantastic opportunity for those students in Years 8, 9 and 10 who are currently studying, intending to study or have an interest in History. Planned activities include visits to Auschwitz-Birkenau, the Wieliczka Salt Mine (a UNESCO World Heritage site), Schindler's Factory and Museum, the Galicia Jewish Museum (where students will meet with a Concentration Camp Survivor) and the Polonia Wax Museum.

The anticipated date of the trip will be 17<sup>th</sup> October 2024 to 20<sup>th</sup> October 2024 however as flights for are not yet on sale for these travel dates this may change slightly.

The cost of the trip is **£765.00** in total. This includes full-board accommodation (breakfast, lunch and dinner), entry to all sites of interest, flights and transfers, insurance and a specialist tour guide.

If you wish your child to be considered for a place on the trip, please **return the reply slip** below to the administration office by **Friday 27<sup>th</sup> October 2023**. Places are available to students in Years 8, 9 and 10 (Years 9, 10 and 11 at the time of the trip) and if the trip is over-subscribed, priority will be given to older students.

If your child is successful in gaining a place, you will be notified by email and will need to pay a deposit of **£150.00** by **Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> November 2023** to secure your place.

Subsequent payment deadlines are as follows:

- £152.00 due by Wednesday 31st January 2024
- £152.00 due by Friday 29th March 2024
- £152.00 due by **Friday 31**st **May 2024**
- Remaining balance of £159.00 due by Friday 5<sup>th</sup> July 2024

Reservation of a place on this trip is dependent upon the continued good behaviour and attitude of your child. Due to the nature of the trip and safety regulations, only students who can be trusted to behave impeccably will be allowed to go.

If your child is successful in gaining a place, but then has to withdraw, any monies paid can only be returned if their place has been filled by another student.

Students will be travelling using their own passports, please ensure they have **at least 6 months** on them from the time of travel. Students will also require a **Global Health Insurance Card** (or EHIC if they already have one
