Humphrey Perkins Prom - Class of 2023

The Prom is an opportunity for our Year 11 cohort to experience a night full of fun with their friends and peers for one last time. There are many reasons to attend the Prom including making long-lasting memories with friends and saying final goodbyes to each other. The Humphrey Perkins Prom Committee is busy planning and arranging the event, which is sure to be an amazing experience.

As Head of Year 11, I hope to see as many Year 11 students as possible, celebrating their five years at Humphrey Perkins, in style. The year group has worked extremely hard to reach this point and will continue to do so throughout the duration of the exam season. They therefore deserve an opportunity to celebrate everything they have achieved.

I delivered an assembly on Friday 17th March about the Prom and the eligibility rules. As this is an optional event and will require staff to supervise during the evening, students attending are expected to have a good behaviour and attendance record before being allowed to purchase a ticket. The final decision for entry to the Prom rests with Mrs Bartram.

Tickets

Tickets will cost £40 and will be available to purchase via Beehive. To secure a place, full payment must be paid by 1st May 2023. (Please note that the tickets are non-refundable). The ticket price includes a two-course meal, live band and disco. It does not include additional soft drinks (approx. £3 each), which will need to be purchased from the alcohol-free bar. Entry to the Prom is by ticket only and therefore if a student is not on the ticket list, they will not be able to gain entry on the night. In the event of this happening parents will be contacted and expected to collect their son or daughter.

Venue

The venue is The Pumping Station, Cropston, LE7 7GB. The dress code is Dress to Impress!

Security

Parents are expected to arrange for students to be dropped off and collected. The venue is secure and cannot be accessed by anyone other than our students and staff. Students will not be allowed to leave the venue during the course of the evening.

Collection

The Prom will finish at 11pm and students will then be available for collection from the venue. Please ensure that there is someone to collect your child as we **cannot let students leave the venue unsupervised**.
