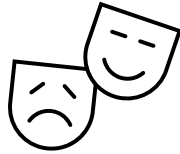

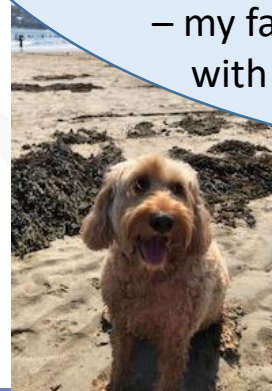


Hi, I'm Mrs Wellington!
