Dear Parents and Carers,

As you are aware, our Year 11 exam season is soon to be in full swing. We are so proud of Year 11, and staff are working hard to ensure that all students achieve the best results of which they are capable.

## Year 11 Immersion Timetable

This year, to support our students even further, we are organising for the first time an **Immersion Timetable** for Year 11. Essentially, this means that from next week, all students will receive a revised timetable linked to their individual examinations. At times, instead of their normal lessons, during the entire exam period, students will participate in a comprehensive programme of workshops and masterclasses, the day before they have an exam. These sessions, delivered by our expert staff (many of whom are examiners) will focus on the essential knowledge and technique required to excel in each paper. Without doubt, this will give our amazing Year 11 students a real advantage over other students across the country.

## Year 11 Attendance

It is essential that all students continue to attend school full time up until **10.30am on Monday 15 June**. Students taking Spanish will also be expected to attend Immersion workshops on **Monday 15 June** and **Tuesday 16 June** (mornings) ahead of their final examination on **Wednesday 17 June**. During this period, students will benefit from dedicated subject-based workshops ahead of each exam. Any absence from school will prevent students from benefiting from our Immersion Revision Programme and will place them at a significant disadvantage. Please support your child by ensuring that they attend school every day throughout the exam season. Please also support your child by ensuring that they bring essential equipment to school each day (2 black pens, 1 sharp pencil, 1 green pen, a rubber, ruler, calculator, protractor and compasses). Intervention/Boost will continue to run after school each day and will be linked to forthcoming exams. To maximise students' potential to achieve their best results, it is imperative that **all external appointments** are made outside school hours.

## Other Opportunities

May I take the opportunity to share with you the additional opportunities we have available to support our students:

- On the morning of each exam, teachers of that subject will be based in the Restaurant to provide reassurance and answer any last-minute queries that students may have. As well as boosting students' confidence, staff will also provide free cereal bars, fruit and bottles of water.
- A dedicated lunch space ensuring students are on the first sitting for lunch and can then informally chat/revise.
