



## Paris 2025 – 16<sup>th</sup> – 20<sup>th</sup> October 2025

Dear Parents/Carers,

I am delighted to announce that the Languages department are once again planning a trip to Paris in October of the 2025-26 Academic Year. Planned activities include a boat cruise on the River Seine, a French food market tour, and visits to the Musée d'Orsay art gallery, Stade de France football stadium, Notre Dame cathedral, as well as walking tours to explore some of Paris' most iconic sights – all topped off with a highly anticipated day at Disneyland Paris.

The cost of the trip is **£750** in total. This includes half-board accommodation (with breakfast at our hotel and dinner at local restaurants), entry to all sites of interest, travel, insurance and the cost of a trip hooded sweatshirt.

For your peace of mind, this trip is being organised by a well-established tour operator and accommodation has been checked and risk assessed by them. Appropriate measures will be taken to ensure that all realistic safety precautions are in place for all trips and visits.

If you wish your child to be considered for a place on the trip, please **return the reply slip** below to Mrs Clarkson (in Admin) by **Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> May 2025**.

Places are available to students in Years 9 and 10 (Years 10 and 11 at the time of the trip) and if the trip is over-subscribed, priority will be given to those students studying French at GCSE.

If your child is successful in gaining a place, you will be notified by text message and will need to pay a deposit of **£100** by **Monday 19<sup>th</sup> May** to secure your place.

The remaining balance will be due before the summer holiday, which we appreciate is an extremely tight turnaround but wish to provide this opportunity to students in their final years at Humphrey Perkins.

Reservation of a place on this trip is dependent upon the continued good behaviour and attitude of your child. Due to the nature of the trip and safety regulations, only students who can be trusted to behave impeccably will be allowed to go.

If your child is successful in gaining a place, but then has to withdraw, any monies paid can only be returned if their place has been filled by another student.
