## Year 7 and 8 End of Term Trips

We would like to end the school year with something special for students in Year 7 and 8 and are planning our end of year trips on Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> July 2026. We have chosen to widen our trips offer as we know that a theme park is not to everyone's liking. Following student voice earlier this year, we have chosen a variety of trips for students to choose from.

This year students have the choice of 4 venues:

### Showcase Cinema and a 2-course meal at Frankie and Benny's - £30

We will be attending and watching a film at Showcase cinema in Leicester followed by a 2-course meal at Frankie and Benny's. A menu choice will be available for students to choose prior to the day. It is likely that the film we will be watching is 'Supergirl: Woman of Tomorrow'. We will have a single occupancy screening and student popcorn, and a drink will be included in the price. We will arrive in Leicester by coach and be collected by coach to be taken back to school at the end of the day.

### East Street Lanes – bowling, crazy golf, arcades and pizza - £40

East Street Lanes have set us up with a very exciting day of bowling, crazy golf, arcade sessions and pizza all within their venue. We will arrive in Leicester by coach and be collected by coach to be taken back to school at the end of the day.

### Megazone – Laser quest and pizza - £25

Megazone have offered us a day of Laser Quest and use of their arcades and pizza for lunch. We will have sole occupancy of the venue. We will arrive in Leicester by coach and be collected by coach to be taken back to school at the end of the day.

### Lego Land - £42

This year we are venturing to Legoland, a great family theme park experience for students to enjoy. In addition, students will also receive a free round of crazy golf within the price of the ticket. We will be travelling to and from the venue via coach which will leave and return from the school site.

To confirm a place on one of the trips, payment will need to be made through Beehive. We are expecting this to be available over the weekend. There will also be a closing date for decision making so that we can ensure logistics of the day can be prepared. Once each trip is full, students will no longer be able to pay for the trip and will have to choose an alternative trip.

Buses for the trips will leave Humphrey Perkins School between 8.30am-9:30am dependant on the trip your child chooses to attend and will drop off at Humphrey Perkins School between 4.30pm and 6.00pm also dependant on the trip choice.

Unfortunately, we will be unable to give refunds after the tickets have been purchased and the buses have been booked.

Research and appropriate measures have been taken to ensure that all realistic safety precautions are in place for all trips and visits. Parents or the school reserve the right to withdraw children from a trip or visit. Where payments have been made, we cannot guarantee refunds will be given.
