Eligibility Rules

- Positive conduct – your conduct cards will be taken into consideration

Prom Ticket – Free Passes

Students will also get a raffle ticket each week they have 100% attendance. We will be drawing the raffle for free prom tickets on a few occasions, with 5 free tickets (or refunds) available.

Tickets

Tickets will cost £45 and will be available to purchase via Beehive from Monday 23rd February. To secure a place, full payment must be paid by 1st May 2026. (Please note that the tickets are non-refundable unless a free ticket is won). The ticket price includes a welcome drink, a two-course meal, disco and unlimited visits to the photobooth. It does not include prints from the professional photographer or additional soft drinks which will need to be purchased from the alcohol-free bar. Entry to the Prom is by ticket only and therefore if a student is not on the ticket list, they will not be able to gain entry on the night. In the event of this happening, parents will be contacted and expected to collect their son or daughter.

Venue

The venue is The Pumping Station, Cropston, LE7 7GB. The dress code is Dress to Impress!

Security

Parents are expected to arrange for students to be dropped off and collected. The venue is secure and cannot be accessed by anyone other than our students and staff. Students will not be allowed to leave the venue during the course of the evening.

Collection

The Prom will finish at 11pm and students will then be available for collection from the venue. Please ensure that there is someone to collect your child as we **cannot let students leave the venue unsupervised**.

Code of conduct

We operate a **strict no alcohol policy**. If a member of staff suspects that a student is under the influence of alcohol or drugs, parents will be informed and will be expected to collect their son/daughter immediately. In the event of illness, parents/carers will be informed and will be asked to collect their child.

Students are expected to behave appropriately for the occasion of a formal evening celebration; they are representing the school. However, should the behaviour of a student during the evening not meet our high expectations, parents/carers will be contacted.

Yearbook

We are also excited to share information on our yearbook. We have outsourced a company to produce our yearbook, an exciting purchase for your child to purchase and treasure as a memory of their time at Humphrey Perkins. The yearbook will cost £10 which will be available to purchase via Beehive. In order for your child's name and photo to be included in the yearbook, can you please complete and return the slip to admin as soon as possible. Without consent, your child will not be part of the yearbook.
