Year 11 Event: The Big Revise - Thursday 19th January 2023 - 3pm to 5pm

Dear Parent/Carer,

I am writing to you following the letters that I sent on 7/12/22 and 4/01/23 to give you information about our 'Big Revise' event for Year 11. This event has been hugely successful and well received by previous Year 11 students across the Lionheart Trust and as a result is an initiative we are very keen to launch at Humphrey Perkins.

On Thursday 19th January 2023 between 3pm and 5pm, there will be a whole year group revision event to help focus and motivate students before their summer exams. This will begin with a whole Year 11 assembly in the hall during the end of the final lesson of the day. Our Year 11 students will be allocated to two intervention sessions. Please note, students will be allocated their revision sessions based on the subject areas in which they need to make the most gains (based on their trial exams) before their exams. This may mean that some students have English and/or Maths as their two sessions; others may have English, Maths or Science for one session and an option choice for the other. In all instances, the sessions allocated for the Big Revise will be specifically targeted to your child's needs; therefore, swapping or changing these sessions will not be permitted.

In between the two sessions, there will be a short 15-minute break where free pizza and juice will be provided for all students. There will be a late bus running for our usual routes at the end of the second session so all students who get the school buses home will be able to attend (this includes mini-bus students). As a school, it is our expectation that all students will attend.

The late bus will make stops as follows: Sileby – Tesco Express; Cossington – bus stop opposite the Royal Oak; Hoton – St Leonard's Church; Wymeswold – Rectory Place bus stop; Burton on the Wolds – bus stop near the Greyhound Inn.

This is a fantastic opportunity to motivate and support the whole year group. At Humphrey Perkins, we want all of our students to work hard and aim high. The Big Revise is a great chance for our students to benefit from targeted intervention with a renewed focus and motivation for their summer exams.

Thank you for your ongoing support and continued partnership in ensuring your child maximises their outcomes in Year 11 and beyond.
