We are excited to announce that Staff and Students at Humphrey Perkins are taking part in a '24-hour Spin Bike Challenge' which starts on Thursday 16th February at 12pm and runs until Friday 17th at 12pm. The challenge is being launched by Elite Olympic Coach – Mel Marshall – Coach of Adam Peaty.

We have set ourselves the fundraising target of £2000 to donate to two amazing charities – The Soar Valley Project and The Volunteer Zambia Project.

Soar Valley Community Project - they support local families with financial support, running over 10 food banks in the Soar Valley area and support adults with applying for jobs and applications for financial hardship funds. Their work is paramount, especially in the current climate; as a school we have made many referrals to the scheme for our families.

Volunteer Zambia Foundation - Mel is Patron of the foundation. Volunteer Zambia is a unique international sport programme which seeks to improve young people's quality of life through sport and recreational activities. Money is raised every year to sustain the Zambian community through new building projects, food campaigns and general living and education resources.

The challenge is for staff and students to keep 5 spin bikes moving for 24 hours; the timings on the bikes will be split into 15-minute blocks. Students will be predominantly manning the bikes during the day with staff taking the lead overnight.

If your child wants the opportunity to participate in the challenge, then they are encouraged to stay after school (2:45pm-5pm). They have the option to stay for as long or as little as they like. For students to take part the permission slip overleaf must be completed and returned to the PE department by Wednesday 15th.
